



Stay alert and protect your company against fraud!

Scammers are posing as Republic Bank's Fraud Department and contacting clients in an attempt to gain access to their accounts. They may be using Caller ID Spoofing to give the appearance of calling from Republic Bank (from 888-584-3600 or one of another of our legitimate phone numbers). If you receive a phone call alerting you about a suspicious transaction on your business account, hang up and contact us immediately to report the issue.

Always remember: Republic Bank will <u>NEVER</u> contact you and ask you for your Secure Access Code, login ID, or any other Business Online Banking login credentials.

Below are a few additional tips to help prevent fraud on your business account:



Be cautious of phishing emails and texts.

- Fraudsters will attempt account takeovers by contacting you from seemingly trustworthy profiles
- Instead of clicking on a suspicious link in an email or text message, always confirm requests with a phone call to your trusted contacts



Avoid mail theft.

- Limit the use of postal collection boxes as they have become highly targeted in recent months
- Use the Business Bill Pay feature to have checks sent safely and securely



Keep your account under your control.
